

Arkansas Rice Research Verification Program Weekly Update

General Information

Rice Research Verification fields are progressing fast with weekly rainfall. Pre-emergence herbicides are breaking and post-emergence herbicides are going out or scheduled for application. The Desha County (FIR) field has received its first shot of nitrogen. Chicot, Poinsett and Prairie Counties are at the 1-2 leaf stage. Crittenden, Jefferson, Lonoke and White Counties are at the 3-4 leaf stage. Woodruff County should be planted at any time.
